FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



DO I NEED PERMISSION TO FUNDRAISE?

You sure do! Fill out the Intention to Fundraise form and email us at fundraise@rescue.org.nz and we will get the process started.

I NEED PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE AND COUNCIL PERMITS FOR MY EVENT; WILL YOU COVER THIS FOR ME?

Our Public Liability Insurance does not extend to third-party fundraising events, so any permits or insurance you need and associated expenses are your responsibility.

CAN I USE MY RESCUE HELICOPTER'S LOGO AND BRANDING TO PROMOTE MY EVENT? You can - we have a specific 'Community Supporter' logo for your fundraising event! Please email **fundraise@rescue.org.nz** and let us know how you're hoping to promote your event so we can have a chat about what you might need. Any collateral that has your rescue helicopter's logo on it will need to be approved by our team so please make sure you send this to us for approval <u>before</u> starting to promote your event.

CREATE A FUNDRAISING PAGE ONLINE

Create a Fundraising page on our website and share it with your friends, family and colleagues. They will be able to donate online easily and you can keep an eye on the donations coming in!

WHAT SUPPORT CAN YOU PROVIDE?

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



CAN YOU PROVIDE AUCTION OR RAFFLE ITEMS FOR MY EVENT?

Due to the number of fundraisers we work with, unfortunately we are unable to provide raffle and auction items. We can help by providing guidance on how to approach businesses for these.

HOW DO I DEPOSIT FUNDS I HAVE RAISED?

CAN I GET A TAX RECEIPT FOR FUNDRAISING? Funds raised through the community cannot be receipted for tax purposes but will receive a

Thank You acknowledgment letter. We can provide individuals with a tax receipt.

HOW DO I THANK PEOPLE THAT HAVE DONATED TO MY ACTIVITY?

A good way to do this will be to post a thank you message on your social media and tag them in it. This will make them feel special and it might also encourage others to donate too.

CAN A CREW MEMBER COME ALONG TO MY EVENT?

We would love to come along to every event however when our crew are on duty they are required to be at the base, and when they're off duty they're spending time with their families. Get in touch with us though and we can chat about how we can support you.

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FUNDRAISING TIPS

SAFETY

Your safety is our number one concern, please do not put yourself at risk when fundraising or collecting cash donations. Please ensure that you have considered any risks or hazards around your activity and have taken the required safety measures.

PLAN & SHOUT OUT ABOUT YOUR FUNDRAISER

Plan your fundraiser and raise awareness by sharing your page with your friends, family and social media on your local community notice boards and groups. We know that people often need a few reminders before they remember to do something, so don't be shy about following up to ask for support. They will appreciate the reminder! Share photos of what you

want to do and keep your supporters updated.

FUNDRAISING GOAL

Set your fundraising goal and have a look at our fundraising ideas to think about what you can do. Whether it be approaching a company to sponsor some items to raffle or a local business to match the funds that you raised, the possibilities are endless.

HAVE FUN!



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FUNDRAISING T&C'S

Our fundraisers are important to us, and so is our brand and reputation. To protect both you and us, we ask that you read through and agree to the following fundraising guidelines:



• You/your organisation, as the authorised fundraiser/s are solely responsible for any activities associated with your fundraising.

• Philips Search and Rescue Trust (PSRT) reserves the right to refuse, or cancel approval of, any fundraising activity that does not align with our brand and values.

• All collateral and material displaying a rescue helicopter logo must be sent to fundraise@rescue.org.nz for approval, before distribution.

 Any promotional material must clearly state that your activities are "raising funds for the (include relevant rescue helicopter)" or that you are "proudly supporting the (include relevant rescue helicopter)". You/your organisation must not be referred to as a sponsor of the rescue helicopter or PSRT. Your event must not be referred to as a PSRT event or include any of our sponsors names in your event name.

• You/your organisation, as the authorised fundraiser/s are responsible for payment of all expenses/invoices pertaining to your fundraising. PSRT is not responsible for any expenses incurred by you/your organisation in undertaking your fundraising activities.

• Please note that our crew are operational and unable to come speak at events without compromising response times to future missions or fatigue management when off duty, therefore only events with donations \$10K+ will be considered for crew attendance. All other events will be considered by the Community Fundraising Coordinator, with an online or in person presentation that contains exclusive information and videos about our awesome crew and the great work they do in the community.

• You/your organisation, as the authorised fundraiser/s, are responsible for gaining any licenses or permits needed for your fundraising activity. PSRT will not provide Public Liability Insurance for third party fundraising activities. This is the sole responsibility of the authorised fundraiser/s.

• Funds raised must be transferred to PSRT within 14 days of the activities being completed. Account Name: Philips Search & Rescue Trust Account Number: 03-1555-0008019-00 Reference number: (Supporter Number/Contact ID)

• You/your organisation, as the authorised fundraiser/s cannot issue receipts on behalf of PSRT. The easiest way for you to promote your fundraiser is by setting up a page through our website. It's very similar to fundraising through Givealittle, but this way we keep all of the donations that come through! You can also advertise and thank people directly through the page.

• If you have received support materials from PSRT for your event, you agree to return these, in their original condition, within one week of the event.

I declare that all information provided to Philips Search and Rescue Trust is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I have read PSRT's Fundraising Guidelines and agree to abide by all conditions contained within these. I agree to indemnify PSRT against any claims arising from my fundraising activities. I understand that PSRT has the right to withdraw my Authority to Fundraise if I am in breach of any of their fundraising guidelines.
